


ILLEGAL U TURN



Fine		Road Rule 132 (2A)
<p>\$265 and 3 demerit points</p>	<p>A driver on a road:</p> <p>with a single continuous dividing line,</p> <p>a single dividing line to the left of a broken dividing line or</p> <p>two parallel continuous dividing lines</p> <p>Must not drive across the dividing lines to perform a U-turn.</p>	



Other Australian Road Rules regulating U-turn:



Australian Road Rule-37-42

Offence description	Fine + Demerit Points	SCHOOL ZONE Fine + Demerit Points
Begin U-turn without view of approaching traffic	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Driver not safely begin U-turn without obstructing traffic	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Make U-turn without giving way to vehicle /pedestrian	\$265 + 3 DP	\$353 + 4 DP
Make U-turn at break in dividing strip contrary to sign	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Make U-turn on length of road contrary to sign	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Make U-turn at intersection with traffic lights	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Make U-turn at intersection (no lights) contrary to sign	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Not start U-turn in lane nearest dividing line/median strip	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
Not start U-turn from left of centre of road	\$206 + 2 DP	\$265 + 3 DP
